meeting information

an open invitation is extended to any woman who has lost a child to miscarriage, stillbirth or infant death. bereaved mothers are welcome whether the loss occurred ten years ago or ten hours ago. all mothers are welcome - those who have no living children; those who have living children; those who are currently pregnant; those who struggle with fertility and those who do not struggle with fertility.

what to bring & meeting format

simply bring yourself to the meeting. all gatherings will open and close with prayer. each mom will be given an opportunity to share as much or as little of her story as she likes. we will listen and learn as we share where we presently are in our individual grief walks. mothers can come to as many or as few meetings as necessary to support their needs. beverages will be provided but consider eating dinner prior to the meeting.
